Spring Concert 2026 Performance Information

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our Spring concert is almost upon us and the children have been working really hard on their performances. As you know, we are having two performances this year, both on Thursday 12th March. The first is at 1:30pm (straight through with no interval) and a later performance at 6:30pm. Please see the information regarding arrangements for each performance below.

Afternoon performance 1:30pm

Children will spend all day at The Point. We will leave school at approximately 9:00am to walk to The Point. We will spend the morning rehearsing and will remain at The Point until the afternoon performance.

As we will be at The Point all day, we ask that children do **not** wear school uniform, but instead wear **black and white clothing** with black shoes. We request that football shirts are not worn. **Dancers** are able to wear the clothes they are wearing for their dance performance, more instructions will come from Michelle at their rehearsals.

Children will also need to bring a **packed lunch** with them to school. If your child is in receipt of Universal Free School Meals (Years R, 1 & 2) or entitled to a statutory Free School Meal, and you would like the school to provide a picnic lunch for your child, please let the office know before the 9th March.

After the performance, children will be walked back to school and released for collection at the normal time. **Please note that children will not be released to parents at the venue.**

Evening performance – 6:30pm

Please ensure your child is at The Point at 6.00pm on Thursday 12th March 2026. Staff will be ready to sign the children in, just the other side of the theatre doors. Ushers will be available to show you where to go. **Please make sure your child is signed in before taking your seat or going home.**

If you are not staying for the performance, you will need to be in the foyer at approximately 8.30pm to collect your child. Please ensure a member of staff has signed your child out before leaving the building. Also, please inform Ms Humphries if somebody else will be collecting your child.

The children should be dressed in black and white clothes as they were in the day. We politely ask that you take their coats away with you as there are no facilities to store them on the night. Drinks will be provided so they will **not** need their water bottles.

KS1 children will be unable to sit within the auditorium during the performances because of the limit of seats available. They will be supervised in the changing rooms backstage. It would be advisable for them to bring in something quiet to keep them busy such as a book, card games or some colouring.

On **Tuesday 10th March** the children will be taking part in rehearsals in school. On **Thursday 12th March**, the children participating in the Spring Concert will be taking part in a full rehearsal at The Point.

If your child is in the Orchestra, performing a solo or playing in an ensemble, please ensure that on these days they bring their instrument (in full working order), any equipment you've been asked to bring in and their music to school with them.

Many thanks for your continued support. We hope you enjoy the event as much as your children have enjoyed practising.
