Whole School Trips, Visitors and Events

Dear Parent/Carer,

The Crescent Primary School aims to provide a rich learning experience to children both in and out of the classroom, and we are pleased to share our schedule of trips, visitors and events for the next academic year.

We have simplified our payment process and are requesting a one-off payment each academic year to cover the cost of all trips taking place. While we have tried to be as accurate as possible with the cost, please be aware these prices and dates may be subject to slight change. Should this happen we will advise you at our earliest opportunity.

One off trip costs will be available to pay on-line through our new payment system Arbor from Monday 15th September and can be paid in full or by installments. Should you wish to pay by installments, please ensure your monthly payments are made by 30th September, 31st October and 30th November 2025.

The total cost for trips (excluding residential) per year group this academic year are as follows;

Year R - £36.55	Year 3 - £34.55	Year 6 – £35.50

Thank you to parents who have already registered with Arbor. If you have not yet registered, login details were re-sent on Friday 5th September. To set up a login for your account, you just need to set a password. Your username is the email address we've sent the email to. Go to <https://login.arbor.sc> and click 'Forgot your password?' to finish setting up your account.

Letters will continue to be sent 1 month before each trip containing all the information you need. You will notice there is now a link to a form on each trip letter you receive. This form is to confirm details such as consent, lunch options, travel sickness, allergies and to volunteer as a parent helper (when needed) and **must be completed prior to each trip**. Without consent, your child will not be able to attend off-site visits.

Unfortunately, we are unable to subsidise trips, therefore if we do not receive at least 85% of the costs, as detailed in the Governor's trip policy, these trips will unfortunately have to be cancelled.


We believe these trips will be beneficial to the children's learning experiences, so it is imperative we receive full payment. The school is not in a position to subsidise trips for pupils, as this impacts negatively on other parts of the school budget.
