Slogan: **'Reach for the stars'**

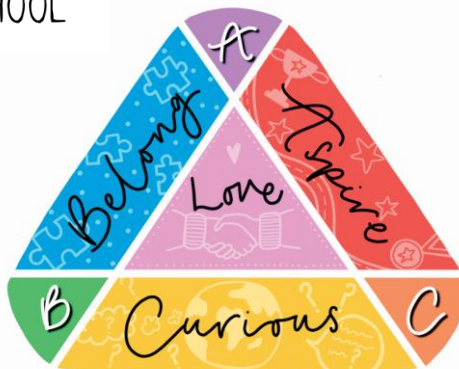
Our Vision:
