Educational visit to Butser Ancient Farm

Dear Parents/Carers,

During the week of **10th November**, Year 3 will be visiting [Butser](#) Ancient Farm as part of our topic 'Stone Age to Iron Age – Who first lived in Britain?'. The visit will give your child the opportunity to experience what life was like in those times. During the visit, the children will be taking part in a range of activities.

Nebula Class will be visiting on Monday 10th November, Galaxy Class will be visiting on Tuesday 11th November and Asteroid Class will be going on Wednesday 12th November.

We plan to leave school at 9.15am and return in time for normal collection at 3.25pm.

Children are required to wear their **school sweatshirt or cardigan**. However, they can wear casual trousers and comfortable footwear (wellies – with thick socks or trainers). Also, children should bring a waterproof jacket or coat as the majority of the trip is outdoors. This will be assessed nearer the time

Children will need to bring a **rucksack** to carry their packed lunch, healthy snack and plenty of drink. Please do NOT provide fizzy drinks or any drinks in glass bottles. If you would like the school to provide your child with a packed lunch, please make sure you complete our online form.

Payments can be made through Arbor, our new payment system, for all trips either in full or by instalments. If you have not yet registered, to set up a login for your account on the new system, you just need to set a password. Your username is the email address we've sent this email to. Go to <https://login.arbor.sc> and click 'Forgot your password?' to finish setting up your account.

We believe this trip will be very beneficial to the children's learning experience. If we do not receive at least 85% of the cost, as detailed in the Governor's trip policy, this trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. If you have a genuine difficulty in making payment, please arrange a confidential appointment with Mr Wartnaby.

Finally, as a school, we have moved away from paper letters and reply slips. Going forward, every parent will need to complete our online [form](#) to confirm details such as consent, lunch option, travel sickness, allergies and to volunteer as a parent helper (when needed).
