The children will then write a letter to the King Charles about our 'journey' to London.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>We will be learning multiplication and division facts. We will also be starting our learning about fractions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>In science, we will be learning all about animals. We will be finding out what animals need in order to survive.</p>

The children will be making vegetable kebabs.</p>
