We hope that you had a lovely half term break and that the children are refreshed. This half term, our topic is called 'How did life and the landscape change from the Stone Age to the Iron Age?'

<p>English</p> <p>This half term, we will be studying the book 'Stone Age Boy', writing our own adventures in this style. We will also be using the text 'The King Who Banned the Dark' to model our short stories on.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be revisiting place value and applying this to measurement. We will be comparing and ordering fractions and applying this to geometry.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In science, we will be learning about light and dark. This will include learning about shadows - what they are and how they change.</p>
<p>ICT</p> <p>Animation - during this unit children will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation. They will apply these skills to create a Stone Age themed animation using knowledge they have learnt from History.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>We will be learning about the Stone Age and Iron Age. We will focus on how life was different from today. This will include a visit to Butser Farm</p>	<p>DT</p> <p>We will be looking at a textile, where we will be designing and making our own money purses.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>Outdoor PE - focusing on teamwork and cooperation in team games.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>This term, we will be expanding our knowledge of pitch and texture as well as using both tuned and un tuned instruments. We will be listening to Chinese music and learning about the pentatonic scale and drones.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>We will be thinking about Friendship. We will also be using the text 'This is Our House', for our 'No Outsiders' curriculum.</p>
