<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>In English, we are looking at the story 'We're Going to Feed the Monster!' We will use this text to learn about prepositions. We will then look at 'Storm Whale' and focus on using descriptive language and vocabulary to write a character description.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths, we are learning about multiplication and division and place value. We will be using repeated addition to multiply and explore how grouping and sharing helps with division. We will then move onto finding 10 ore of a given number.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>Our topic this term is 'Which UK country would you like to live in?' We will be looking at the UK countries, their famous landmarks, cultural traditions and languages to help us find our answer.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>We will be labelling and grouping data as part of our Computing unit. We will then use our sorting skills to answer questions about data.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>We will be learning about everyday materials. We will be investigating a range of materials and deciding what would be the best material for building a house for the 3 Little Pigs.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>This term, we will be exploring the print work of William Morris. His work will inspire us to create our own print pieces onto material.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>Our focus this half term is target games. We will be refining our throwing skills to aim for a target.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>We will be learning about steel pans. As a school we have hired a class set of steel pans so the children can experience an instrument from a very different part of the world. We will have at least two weeks to play this Caribbean tuned percussion instrument so make sure you ask them all about what they have learnt!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p>This half term, we will be thinking about healthy relationships and valuing differences.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>This half term, we will be focussing on the Easter Story and linking this to the themes of sadness and happiness.</p>
