Year One Newsletter Autumn 2 - 2025

We hope that you had a lovely half term break and that the children are refreshed and ready for our exciting term ahead! This half term, our topic is called 'Who was Mary Anning and what did she teach us about the past?'

<p>English</p> <p>This half term, we will be looking at a range of 'winter' themed texts. The children will be writing sentences to go with the books.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be learning to count in 2s. We will also learn how to share and group objects equally and find half of a quantity and a shape.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>We will be learning about seasonal changes. The children will be looking at changes that happen during each season including the weather.</p>
<p>Computing</p> <p>We will be creating media through digital painting.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>In History, the children will be learning about Mary Anning. They will research what she did and why it was important. They will also be making their own fossils.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>The children will be looking at art work by Yayoi Kusama and create their own piece inspired by her work.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>In PE, we will be learning to control our movements and balance in gymnastics and individual skills leading to invasion games.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>In Music, exploring the building blocks of music. We are getting to grips with pitched notes on the music stave and how to recognise them..</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE, we will be learning about keeping ourselves safe including ICT use, road safety and keeping safe in the environment.</p>
<p>RE - We will be learning about Candlelight as symbol in the Christmas story.</p>		

PE will continue to take place on a Monday and a Tuesday. Please ensure that your child has a PE kit in school all week and now that the weather is changing, a pair of jogging bottoms or leggings.
Reading will continue to be a key focus this term so your child will need their reading books, library books and logs in school every day. Please remember that as part of your child's homework they should be reading at home five times over the course of a week and this must be recorded in their logs.
