Year Four Newsletter

We hope that you had a lovely half term break and the children are excited for what is ahead this term!

This half term our History question is

'What have the Saxons ever done for us?'

<p>English</p> <p>We will be reading Thames and Tide Club and learning about mudlarking. Children will link their writing to discovering an Anglo-Saxon artefact and writing a diary entry.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Our Science unit is on electricity. This term, we will be making circuits and we will be learning about insulators and conductors.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>This term, we will be focusing on multiplication and division. We will also continue to focus on learning our times tables.</p>
<p>Music</p> <p>Year 4 will continue their instrumental learning on the recorder, learning new notes and possibly playing something Christmassy!</p>	<p>History</p> <p>For our History topic, we will be learning about what Anglo-Saxon life was like for different groups of people. We will also be learning how life changed in Britain following the Anglo-Saxon settlement.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>For Art this term, we will be focusing on the artist: Annie Albers. We will be looking at weaving patterns and creating our own final piece linked to weaving.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>This term, the children are learning how to play Volleyball. We will focus on a number of skills before building up to play a full game.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>During this unit children will create programs by planning, modifying, and testing commands to create shapes and patterns. They will use Logo, a text-based programming language. This unit is the first of the two programming units in Year 4, and looks at repetition and loops within programming.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>We will be learning about how to keep well and stay healthy, focussing on personal hygiene.</p>
