Young Voices Concert January 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

To enhance our music programme, we have decided to participate in the **Young Voices 2026** performance at the **02 Arena in London**. It is an unforgettable experience with lighting, sound and special guests. I am delighted to invite your child to take part in this opportunity to sing with school choirs from across the country.

The event takes place on **Thursday 22nd January 2026** but we need your support and commitment early on to ensure everything runs smoothly. Please take a moment to complete our online form to confirm your child is interested in participating. The organisation required for an event of this nature is quite extensive, and your timely response will help us immensely in our planning.

There are 40 places available that will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The event comes with a charge of **£33** per pupil which covers the cost of the event fee and the coach to and from London. Payments will open in September and will be scheduled as follows:

£11.00 on or before 30th September
£11.00 on or before 31st October
£11.00 on or before 30th November

Before you commit, please be aware that the children will leave for the venue after registration but will not return from London until after the concert has finished. This is likely to be after midnight. Confirmation of pick up arrangements and timings will be shared nearer the time.

There is an opportunity to buy a Young Voices t-shirt to wear at the event at an additional cost of £15. However, a plain white t-shirt can be worn instead. Please select the option to buy a t-shirt on the attached form.

Tickets for families to attend the event will be available through an online parent portal. If your child is lucky enough to be one of the first 40 to secure a place, you will receive details of how to purchase tickets. Please be aware that tickets sell out quickly and we cannot guarantee anybody tickets to see their child. Also, children will travel to and from the venue on the coach and will be collected from the school. We cannot allow children to be collected from the venue.

Your child **must** be available for the day of the concert. Unfortunately, refunds cannot be given as we have to make an advanced payment and commitment on numbers. Also, by signing up for the event, your child is committing to choir rehearsals that will take place on a lunchtime from September.

This is a spectacular experience that we are only opening up to the current Year 4 and 5 pupils, please complete and submit our online [form](#) if you would like your child to participate.
