<p>Communication & Language</p> <p>We will be continuing to develop our vocabulary and work on being able to answer 'where' and 'when' questions. We are starting by discussing our half term holiday.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>This half term we will be developing throwing and catching in a game situation. We will also be developing our skills and teamwork ready for sports day on Tuesday 18th June 2019.</p>	<p>Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <p>The topic this half term is 'Moving On' in preparation for moving into Year One. We will be doing weekly swaps with Year 1 staff to develop good relationships. These visits will inform our decision for new classes. You will find out your child's Year 1 teacher on Thursday 27th June 2019.</p>
<p>English</p> <p>We are developing our handwriting and producing longer pieces of writing. We will start by reading non-fiction books about holidays. Then will be writing postcards and information about different environments. We will be reading stories from other cultures and countries. We will go on to read stories and poetry about the sea.</p>		<p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths this half term, we are continuing to count, recognise and order numbers to 20 and beyond. We shall also be continuing to double and halve numbers to 20. We will be counting on and back for addition and subtraction. We will also be looking at capacity and directions.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>We will be exploring creating pictures and models using a variety of pastels, paints and materials. We will make Rainbow fish, Beach collages and boats. We will also be learning songs and dances for our concert.</p>		<p>Knowledge & Understanding of the World</p> <p>This half term, we will be looking closely at the similarities and differences between different countries and areas. We will be talking about the places we have visited and would like to visit. We will be creating holiday role play areas.</p>
