At The Crescent Primary School, we aim to provide children with a rich range of learning experiences both in and beyond the classroom. We are pleased to share our programme of trips, visits and events for the 2026/27 academic year.

The total cost of trips and events for Year 6 during the 2026/27 academic year will be £32.20 (exc residential trip)

While we have tried to provide the most accurate information possible, please be aware that dates and costs may be subject to change. Should any amendments be necessary, we will inform you at our earliest opportunity.

All trips are available online via Arbor, allowing payments to be made at your convenience. A letter will be sent approximately two months before each trip, providing further details about the event and offering the opportunity to either pay in full or follow a recommended payment plan.

You may choose to spread the cost throughout the year by making smaller, regular payments. For example:

- £1.00 to £2.00 per week, or
- £5.00 to £10.00 per month.

Please note that all payments must be received before the event takes place.

Unfortunately, the school is unable to subsidise educational visits. In accordance with the Governors' Trips Policy, if we do not receive at least 85% of the total trip cost through voluntary contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled.

We believe these experiences make a valuable contribution to children's learning and development, and we therefore encourage families to support them where possible. The school is not in a position to fund any shortfall, as this would have a negative impact on other areas of the school budget.

If you are experiencing genuine difficulty in making a payment, please contact the school office to arrange a confidential appointment with Mr Wartnaby.

There may also be additional opportunities offered to the school throughout the year. Should these arise, we will notify you as soon as possible.
