<p>English</p> <p>In English, we will be reading 'How to catch a star' by Oliver Jeffers and creating explanations for this text.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths, we will be revisiting addition and subtraction using money, multiplication and division with the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables and then fractions of numbers and shapes.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In science, we will be learning all about materials. This will include identifying different materials and their purposes.</p>
<p>Computing</p> <p>The children will be looking at how algorithms are used. They will then create their own algorithms to move objects on the screen.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>In history, we will be sequencing the events of the moon landing and understanding why Neil Armstrong was a brave person. The children will then compare this bravery to Ibn Battuta.</p>	<p>DT</p> <p>The children will be looking at designs of vehicles. They will be designing and creating their own moon buggies.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>The children will develop tactical awareness, speed, timing and self-confidence through a range of various outdoor games.</p> <p>PE days are Tuesday and Thursday</p>	<p>Music</p> <p><u>When Skip met Step</u></p> <p>This unit introduces the musical stave to the children and the idea of a step, skip and repetition within melodies. They will use the picture book When Step met Skip to take them on this journey.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>We will be looking at how friendships can develop and change over time.</p>
