Welcome back! We hope you had a restful Easter break. We have a lot of fun curriculum opportunities coming up over the next six weeks!
Our Topic this half term has a history focus, and we will be asking the questions: What did the Roman's do for Britain?'

<p>English</p> <p>We will be exploring the non-fiction text 'Meet the Ancient Romans' and writing to inform through a non-chronological report. We then move on to the text 'The Corinthian Girl', where we will be writing to persuade.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>This term we will be learning continuing to learn how to multiply and divide. We will be looking at how to find remainders of amounts and then move onto geometry learning.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>Our topic this term is focused on the question, 'What was the Roman Empire's most significant impacts on Britain? We will be learning about the impact that the Romans have had on Britain and what evidence we have to support this.</p>	
<p>Computing</p> <p>This unit explores the links between events and actions, while consolidating prior learning relating to sequencing. Children will begin by moving a sprite in four directions (up, down, left, and right). They will then make a game using these directions.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Our Science this term is continue our learning about plants. We will look at how plants reproduce and how seeds are dispersed.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>This half term we will be learning about rights and responsibilities of being a good citizen within our school and local area.</p>	
<p>RE</p> <p>We will be learning about the meaning of identity, focusing on the Sikh story of Baisakhi.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>The children will be exploring and improving their playing skills by learning a piece of music called 'Enchanted Forest'. They will sing, chant and learn to play the notes B, A and G on the recorder.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>PE will be taught on a Wednesday afternoon by class teachers and then on a Thursday afternoon with Mr Tavendar.</p>	<p>D.T.</p> <p>In DT this term the children will be designing and making a packaging for Roman artefacts. They will investigate existing packaging and then design their own with a purpose.</p>
