Our text driver will be 'Holes' and we will be writing character descriptions and setting descriptions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In maths, we will be revisiting different mathematical topics over the term. This will include: fractions, decimals and percentages. After this, we will be revisiting graphs and tables.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>We will be designing and creating out final collages inspired by the work of Beatriz Milhaze. We explored her work last term and began to experiment with layering.</p>

We will also begin our work on preparing the children for transition to secondary school.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>In science, our topic is: Animals including Humans – the heart and health. We will be investigating how blood is transported around the body and the impact of exercise and diet.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>This unit explores pitch dynamics and tempo, in particular how the Arabic / double harmonic scale can be used to create a specific mood when combined with changes in dynamics and tempo.</p>
