# Year One Newsletter Summer 2 2026



We hope that you had a lovely half term break. This term our topic focus question is 'What is the difference between Eastleigh and the rainforest?' We will be learning about why they are so different.

As the weather gets warmer, please ensure your child brings a named hat and water bottle to school.

<p><b>English</b></p> <p>We will create our own imaginative retelling of 'Whistleless', bringing the story to life through role-play. We will experiment with compound sentences and powerful vocabulary to make our storytelling exciting.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>In Maths, we will be looking at place value to 100. We will be recapping our knowledge of fractions and time. We will also learn about capacity, discovering and comparing the volume that different containers can hold.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>We will be learning about plants. The children will learn what plants need in order to grow. They will also learn some names of common plants and trees.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>We will be learning more about programming using 'Scratch'. The children will create and programme their own sprites.</p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>We will be exploring the differences between Eastleigh and the rainforest, discovering how different two places can be.</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>The children will be looking at sculptures by Alexander Calder. They will be creating their own sculptures using paper.</p>
<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>PE will be taught on a Monday by class teachers. Children will be focussing on their striking skills. They will also have PE on a Tuesday with Mr Tavender.</p> <p><b>Please ensure your child has their full PE kit in school.</b></p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>We will be looking through the castle doors to see what we can see and hear behind them. Focusing on the timbre of the music, we will explore what noises we can make with our bodies, voices and instruments. We will use ICT to alter and record the sounds that we make.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>We will be continuing with our No Outsiders scheme looking at the importance of friendships. Towards the end of the term, we will also be talking about the transition into Year 2.</p>
<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>We will be looking at the concept of 'preciousness' using water as our theme and how it is used in both Hindu and Christian religions.</p>
