Hopefully, summer has now arrived as we reach the final half term of the year! We have a fun and action-packed term planned and the children will have the usual opportunity to meet their new teacher and get a taste for next year. This term our topic question is, 'Will I ever see the water I drink again?'

<p>English</p> <p>The children will be working on the text 'Beneath My Feet' in their English lessons and producing a scientific fold out fact file. They will also be studying the text 'River Stories' in their guided reading sessions.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>The children will be learning about measurement, concentrating mainly on money and length in a variety of contexts. We will also be having a big push on learning the times tables.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p><i>Animals and Humans</i> We will be learning about the human skeleton, comparing it to animal skeletons and thinking about how our skeleton and muscles support us. We will be visiting Winchester Science Centre to learn more about our muscles.</p>
<p>ICT</p> <p>In this unit the children will develop their understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one. They will gain an understanding of what attributes are and how to use them to sort groups of objects by using yes/no questions. They will create physical and on-screen branching databases. Finally, they will evaluate the effectiveness of branching databases and will decide what types of data should be presented as a branching database.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>The children will be learning about the water cycle and how important water is to use. They will look at water pollution and how water is treated.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>In Art this term we will be studying the work of Banksy and Kara Walker, using their work as an inspiration to create our own stencils and silhouettes.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>The children will be focusing on dance and linking repeated movements. For outside PE, the children will be learning a range of athletic skills.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>The Enchanted Forest:</p> <p>The children will continue their learning of the recorder through a piece of music call <i>The Enchanted Forest</i>. Having already learnt how to play the notes A, B and G, they will now begin to compose their own music for the instrument.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE, the children will be learning about Rights and Responsibilities. They will also be learning about money - spending, saving and budgeting.</p>
<p>RE- This term, we will be learning about 'Special Books', focusing on the importance of the Bible to Christians and the Guru Granth Sahib to Sikhs.</p>
