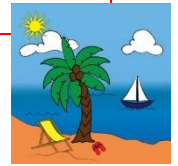

Year 0 Newsletter - Summer 2 2025



In the final half term we will be following the topic 'We're All Going on a Summer Holiday'. The good weather is finally here and it is vital your child has a hat and water bottle every day. We are very active in Year R and so ask that children continue to wear shoes rather than sandals.

<p>Communication & Language</p> <p>We will be continuing to develop our vocabulary and work on being able to answer 'where' and 'when' questions. We are starting by discussing our holiday experiences.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>This half term we will be developing throwing and catching in a game situation. We will also be developing our skills and teamwork ready for sports day.</p>	<p>Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <p>Our No Outsiders book is 'Mummy, Moma and Me' which focuses on celebrating family. We will also be looking at any worries the children have about moving to Year 1 and developing strategies to cope with change. We will be developing friendships and getting to know the children who will be in our new classes.</p>
<p>English</p> <p>We are developing our handwriting and producing longer pieces of writing. We will be reading 'What the Ladybird Heard at the Seaside' and learning about holidays. Then will be writing postcards and information about different environments. We will be reading stories from other cultures and countries. We will go on to read stories and poetry about sea creatures.</p>		<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths this half term, we are continuing to count to 20 and beyond. We shall also be continuing to double and halve numbers to 10. We will be counting on and back for addition and subtraction. Developing our quick fire 1 more/1 less to 10. We will also be looking at capacity, money and directions through play.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>We will be exploring creating pictures and models using a variety of pastels, paints and materials. We will make fish, beach collages and boats. The children will be finding, singing and playing along to the steady beat of music. e will focus in on the duration of Chinese music, pretending to be dragons moving steadily to the music.</p>		<p>Knowledge & Understanding of the World</p> <p>This half term, we will be looking closely at the similarities and differences between different countries. We will be talking about the places we have visited and would like to visit. We will be creating holiday role play areas. We will also be talking about seasons and signs of summer.</p>
