I thought it would be useful to inform you of the particular areas we will be focusing on in Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) during this half-term. This may help you prepare for the possible questions or topics your child might wish to discuss.

SRE is a compulsory part of our Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education Curriculum taught throughout the school. In year 4, children will learn about:

- The correct terminology for parts of the body
- The physical changes that occur during the period of puberty
- Who they can talk to if they have any worries

To support the work in class children will be watching DVD materials from Channel 4's 'Living and Growing' series:
